## • Brief description of the internship:

During my internship in Jordan, I had the opportunity to work on a project with a focus on the green transition and green skills of Jordanian youth. This internship was a unique and enlightening experience that allowed me to dive into the world of environmental sustainability and youth empowerment. The main objective of my internship was to **conduct research on the green skills** and aspirations of Jordanian youth. To achieve this, I developed a comprehensive questionnaire and conducted interviews with young people across the country. The data collected through these surveys and interviews were crucial in understanding the perceptions and needs of Jordanian youth in relation to environmental sustainability.

One of the most rewarding aspects of this internship was the opportunity to compile the gathered data into **draft policy papers and position papers**, which will be in future sent to local policy makers and NGOs. By translating the research findings into actionable policy suggestions, we aimed to promote sustainable practices and policies that could benefit both the environment and the youth of Jordan.

In addition to the research and policy work, I also had the chance to lead workshops on climate change and environmental sustainability. These workshops were designed to raise awareness among Jordanian youth about the pressing issues surrounding climate change. It was inspiring to witness the engagement and enthusiasm of the participants as they learned about the global environmental challenges and discussed potential solutions. These workshops not only empowered the youth with knowledge but also fostered a sense of responsibility and commitment to taking action to mitigate climate change.

## • Description of the activities:
